You can make a difference for persons with disabilities riding UTA Services. For more than a decade, the Committee on Accessible Transportation (CAT) has helped improve accessibility on UTA. The CAT has made recommendations ranging from access ramps to audible announcements on UTA Bus, TRAX, FrontRunner, BRT and Paratransit services.

Diversity on CAT

Having a diverse committee representing various disabilities and ages is one of the CAT's strengths. The goal of the CAT is to include members who represent a wide range of disabilities. Every effort is made to include members from various ethnic, economic and geographic backgrounds as well. This diversity mean that CAT



members have unique perspectives on how to improve a rider's experience.

Benefits of Being a CAT Member

CAT members receive several benefits for their service. Here are a few you'll be sure to love:

- ***Making a Positive Difference*** - Members of the CAT feel great knowing they are part of the process to improve transit services.
- ***Networking*** - CAT members have the opportunity to meet and work with others from the disability community.
- ***Transit Pass*** - Each CAT member in good standing receives a \$40 Punch Pass each month, good on UTA Paratransit services. The punch pass can be transferred to a UTA FAREPAY card, too, if you prefer.

CAT Member Responsibilities

Here are some commitments that CAT members have:

- ***Attend General CAT Meeting*** - The full CAT meets every other month (six times a year).



- ***Attend Sub Committee Meetings*** - Each CAT committee member will serve on a subcommittee which meets every month (twelve times a year).
- ***Annual Recruitment Open House*** - As a CAT member, you will attend the annual recruitment open house and help recruit new members to serve on the Committee.
- ***Annual Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Celebration*** - As a CAT member, you help plan the annual ADA Celebration, which takes place each year in July to commemorate when the ADA was signed into law in 1990.
